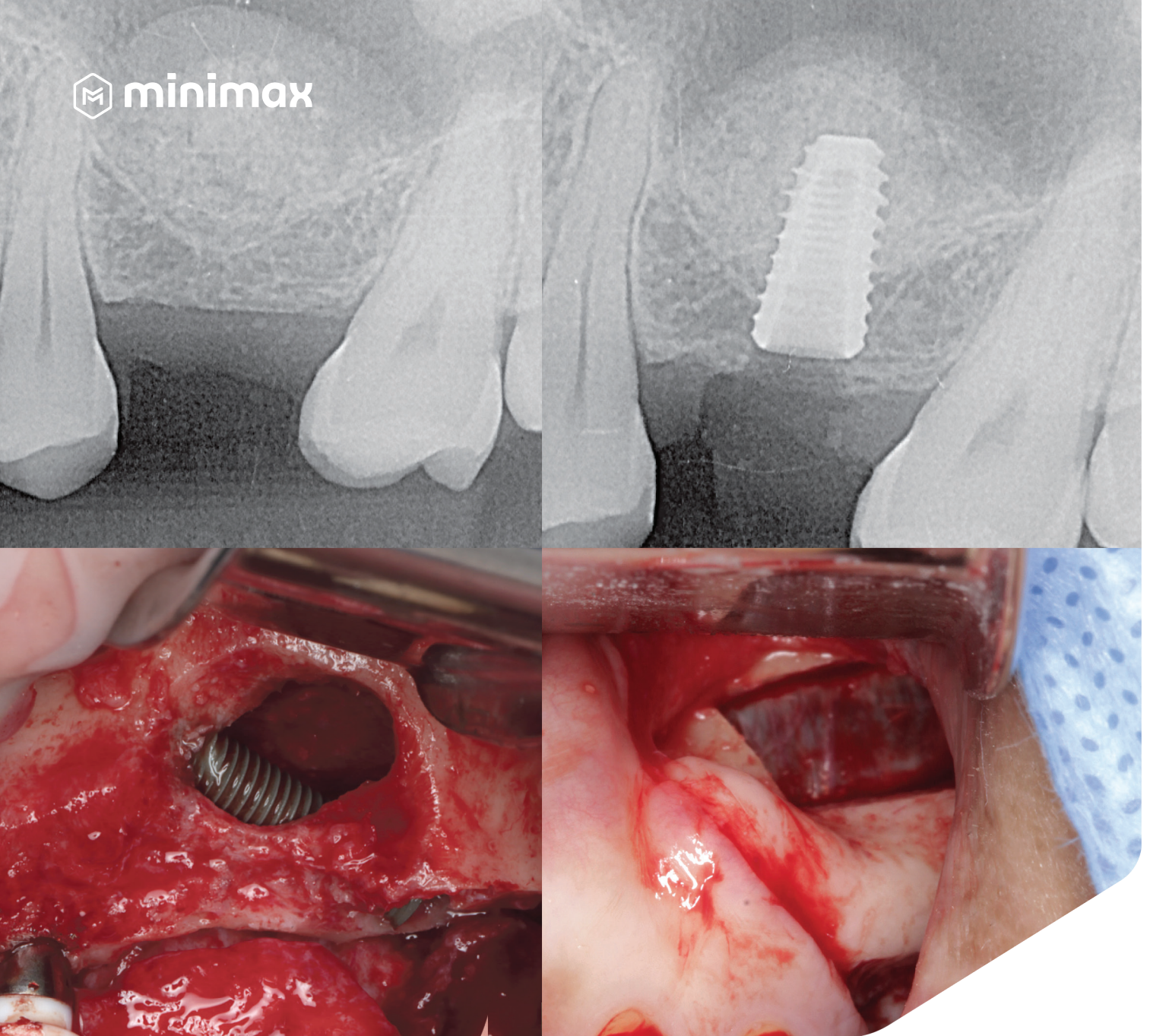

Course Overview

This course, led by Dr. Alex Min, provides a comprehensive overview of sinus augmentation techniques for implant placement in the posterior maxilla. It covers both lateral and crestal approaches, outlining when and how to apply each method. The lecture explores sinus anatomy, residual bone height considerations, and the management of complications such as membrane perforation and infection. Clinicians will also learn about the selection of grafting materials, including autografts, xenografts, and concentrated growth factors. Through clinical cases and evidence-based protocols, participants will gain the confidence to perform sinus lifts safely and predictably.

- Understand the anatomical and clinical factors influencing sinus lift decisions.
- Factors to consider when determining whether to use the lateral or crestal approach.
- Learn to manage and prevent Schneiderian membrane perforations and other common complications.
- Evaluate the pros and cons of various grafting materials used in sinus augmentation.
- Apply evidence-based techniques for predictable outcomes in implant placement with limited bone height.
- Managing complications including the sinus membrane perforation

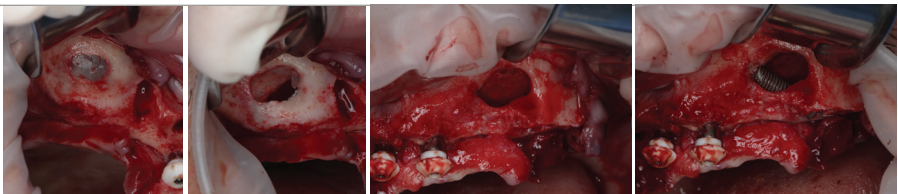

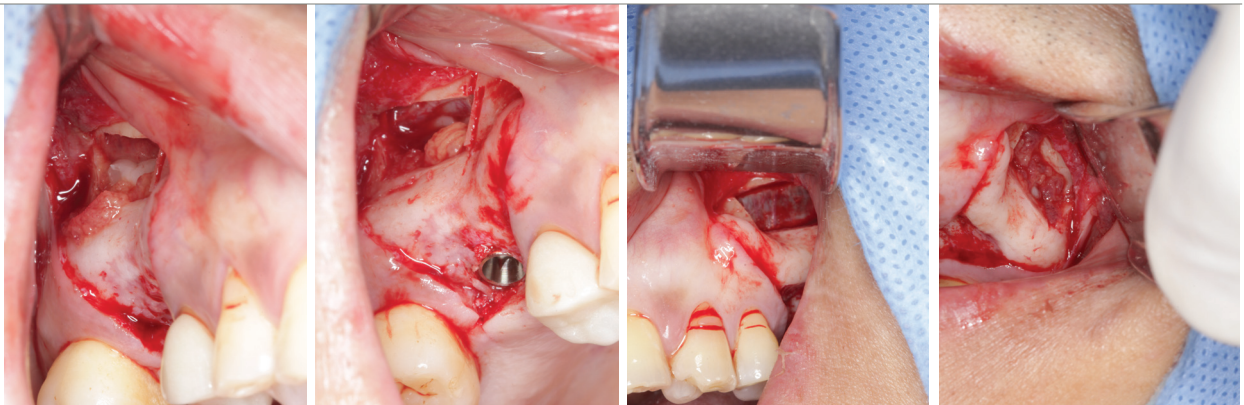

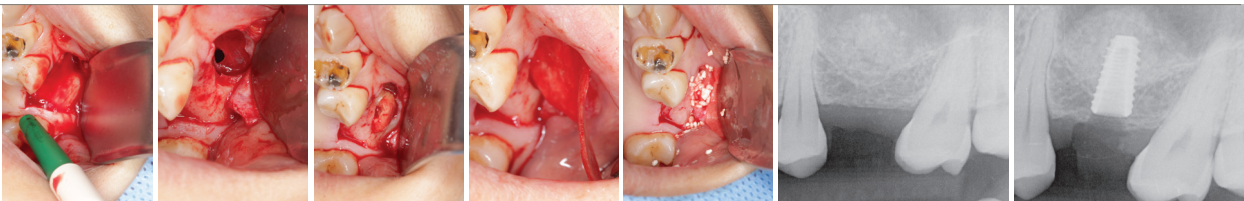
