Course Overview

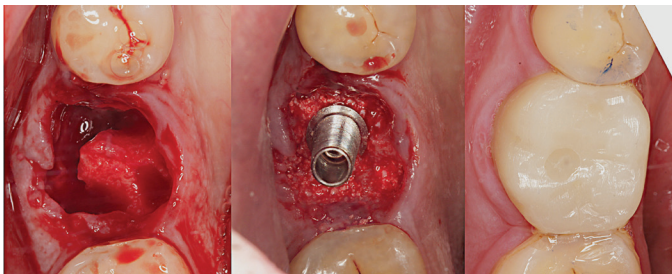
This course provides a comprehensive overview of immediate implant therapy, covering biological principles, CBCT-based diagnosis, risk assessment, surgical planning, site-specific treatment protocols, atraumatic extraction techniques, grafting materials selection, guided bone regeneration (GBR), soft tissue management, and immediate provisionalisation.

Participants will explore immediate implant placement protocols for anterior, premolar, and molar sites, as well as connective tissue grafting, crestal sinus floor elevation, socket preservation, alveolar ridge preservation, custom healing abutment design, and suturing principles in implant surgery.

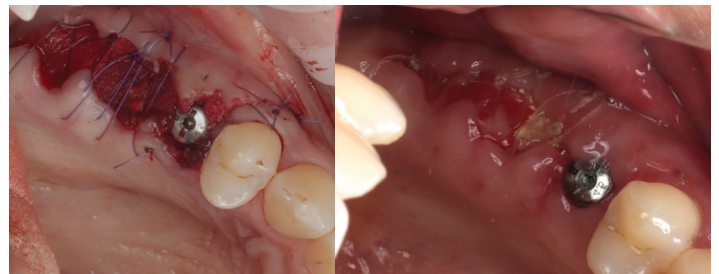

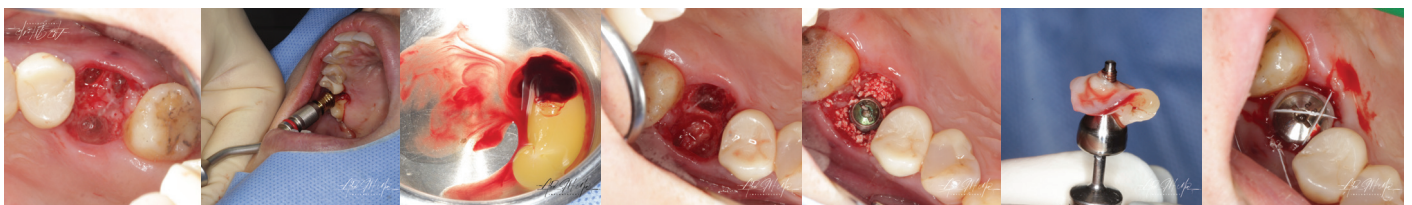

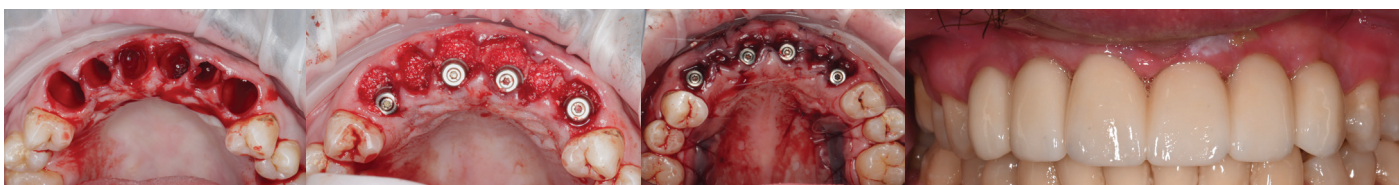

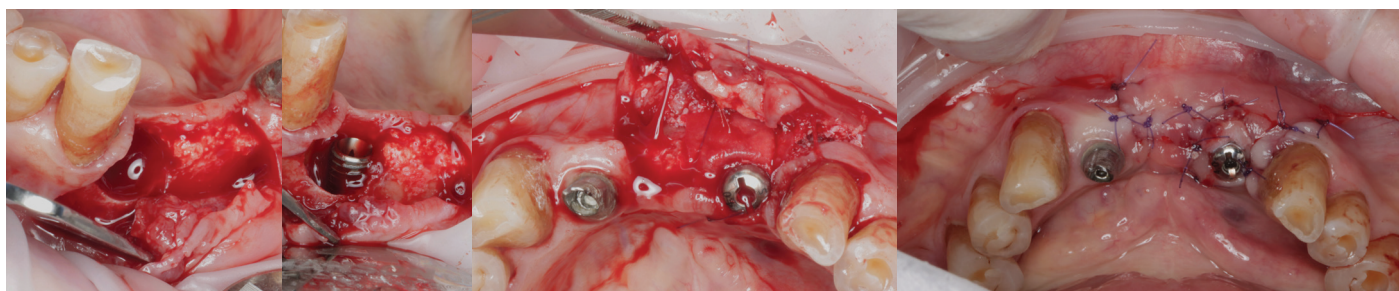
